

Reduced Cost Bupropion *for Your Patient*

In order for your patient to receive bupropion, please adhere to the following instructions:

- Patients must obtain a prescription from their physician for bupropion. Once they have the prescription they must mail it along with the \$5 co-pay to:

- The patient then must call the Montana Tobacco Quit Line at **1-800-QUIT-NOW** (1-800-784-8669), enroll in the program and complete the required coaching calls, which include 5 throughout the 3 months, in order to receive the full 3 months of bupropion.
- The physician may also fax the prescription to Ridgeway Pharmacy at 406-642-6050, and then ask the patient to call Ridgeway Pharmacy with a credit or debit number or mail in the \$5 co-pay.

Reduced Cost CHANTIX *for Your Patient*

For your patient to receive CHANTIX,
follow these instructions:

- Patients must obtain a prescription from their physician for Chantix. Once they have the prescription they must mail it along with the \$50 co-pay to:

- The patient then must call the Montana Tobacco Quit Line at **1-800-QUIT-NOW** (1-800-784-8669), enroll in the program and complete the required coaching calls, which include 3 throughout the 2 months, in order to receive the full 2 months of Chantix.
- The physician may also fax the prescription to Ridgeway Pharmacy at 406-642-6050, and then ask the patient to call Ridgeway Pharmacy with a credit or debit number or mail in the \$50 co-pay.

FREE NRT

In order for your patient to receive
FREE Nicotine Replacement Therapy,
they must follow these instructions:

- ***Fill out a fax referral form, fax it to 1-800-261-6259 and the Montana Tobacco Quit Line will call your patient or your patient can enroll themselves by calling the quit line at 1-800-QUIT-NOW.***
- ***Once enrolled, with help from the quit coach, the patient will determine which form of NRT (patches, gum or lozenges) would best suit their needs.***
